Psychosocial	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver confrontational about not being allowed access • Personnel feeling stress of confrontational drivers • Tedious work, low levels of activity 	HIGH	N/A	<p>Substitute: N/A</p> <p>Isolate: N/A</p> <p>Engineering:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure shelter has a lockable door for protection if situations escalate to violence <p>Administrative:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide effective training and resources • Allow Security Concierge access to Ryman EAP service • Provide easy escalation process eg: walkie talkie/phone for communication within Village, a phone for emergency services escalation such as police, a panic button in case phone is unable to be used ie: medical emergencies, violence • Ensure regular rest breaks away from area • Provide comfortable seating for times of low activity • Provide regular check-ins with Manager to support workers who may be feeling stressed or isolated • Working in pairs should be the standard • Ensure H&S incident reporting procedures are known by the security personnel <p>PPE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide Ryman PPE ie: team inclusion 	LOW
